Dick was commissioned an officer in the Civil Engineer Corps of the U.S. Navy and served in Vietnam. After completion of his service, he was employed in the Vermont Department of Forest and Parks as a Park Engineer and worked on water and wastewater systems, roadways and park development for the State Parks in Vermont.

Mr. Truell joined Willis Engineering Associates as a senior engineer responsible for the overall engineering effort of the company. Mr. Truell eventually purchased the assets and ongoing projects of Willis and formed his own firm in 1975, which he operated for 29 years. In 2004, he sold the assets and projects to Jeremy Matosky and continued working on a reduced schedule.

Mr. Truell has also served as Chairman of both the Planning Commission and Design Review Board of the City of Winooski and served as a member of the Vermont Technical College Advisory Board and Chairman of the Winooski Republican and Grand Isle Republican Committees and Chairman of the Grand Isle County Republican Committee. He is a Colonel in the Vermont State Guard, and the Program Director of the Community Emergency Response Teams (CERT) for Grand Isle County. Mr. Truell is President of the Christian Action Ministry (CAM) Network in Vermont.
